Standard Rooms have a Double Bunk and a Single Roll-Away Bed and can accommodate 5 max.

Room 1 & 7 have two double bunks.

Room 6 has a double bunk and a single bunk.

Room 12 has a double bunk and three single bunks.

Room 14 has 3 single bunks and a double sofa bed.

* Please note that Rooms 13 & 14 are upstairs in the top of the lodge and are only available if all other rooms are also booked – they are not available from July to September.

Room allocation is not guaranteed and may be varied at Tasmanian Rover Ski Club's discretion.

Additional Terms for Group Bookings

- Minimum 3 night stay (July to September), with all rooms to be booked for the same dates.
- Lodge facilities (including common areas) will not be available before check-in at 4pm, or after check-out at 10am. If use of the lodge is needed after 10am then an extra night's accommodation should be booked. Luggage storage after checkout is available.
- Groups are strongly encouraged to book 6 rooms. Bookings for fewer rooms will be allocated in a second round based on remaining availability.
- Based on the information provided, the Booking Officer will provide a quotation with proposed dates. A cleaning bond of \$100 per room will be included in the quotation, and will be refunded if cleaning is satisfactory. To confirm the booking a single credit/debit card must be provided and the quotation paid in full within 48 hours of the time the quotation is sent.
- A responsible person from each room must accompany the lodge manager on a briefing tour on arrival at the lodge.
- Once confirmed, group bookings are not refundable, and dates cannot be changed. Substitutions are allowed if a person in the original booking is unable to attend.
- Groups are responsible for removing all their rubbish and recycling from the mountain at the end of their stay.

Terms & Conditions

Individuals wishing to stay with the Tasmanian Rover Ski Club, must become Affiliate Members. Affiliate Membership is an additional cost of \$1 per person.

The lodge is a family style hostel. Rooms are heated and include a bottom sheet, pillow and pillow case. You must supply your own sleeping bags or quilts and towels (including hand towels and bath mats).

Kitchen, dining and lounge areas offer self-catering facilities. There are no restaurants, pubs, shops or petrol stations on the mountain, and you must bring your own food and beverages. Kitchen and Common areas to be cleaned after each use. Remember, other people have to use these areas so please be as courteous as possible. As a hostel, prior to check out it is required that each room be cleaned and vacuumed.

As the lodge is located within the Ben Lomond National Park, all visitors are required to have a current Parks Pass (details here: www.parks.tas.gov.au/entry-fees). If you drive to the top of the mountain you must carry snow chains and will be required to fit them to your vehicle when the weather or a park ranger dictates. Alternatively, there is usually a shuttle bus from the lower car park to the top of the mountain, bookings may be required. The lodge is located 160m along Village Road, and you will need to transport your own luggage from the car park to the lodge.

Infants: You must supply your own bedding for infants, or use the existing bedding in the room - no additional bedding can be supplied. Infants must also become Affiliate Members, and you must select the Infant Affiliate Fee under Extra's when booking the room.

Check-In is after 4PM, and Check-Out is prior to 10AM. Luggage storage is available on request. All bookings must include an Adult over the age of 18 years. Children are between 4 and 18 years, infants are up to 3 years.

The Tasmanian Rover Ski Club reserves the right, at their sole discretion, to:

- eject any person without refund for unsocial or inappropriate behaviour (including use or possession of illegal substances).
- charge a reasonable amount to the credit card used for the booking to cover any damage caused.
- charge a cleaning fee of up to \$100 per room to the credit card used for the booking if the room is not left in a satisfactory condition prior to departure.
- charge a late check out fee up to a full nights rate to the credit card used for the booking if the room is not vacated by 10AM on the day of departure.
- place bookings in a different room to which was booked provided there are sufficient sleeping spaces for the number of persons in the booking.

Tasmanian Rover Ski Club accepts no responsibility for damage or loss of any property left on the premises prior to, during or after a stay. Only persons listed on a booking and paying an affiliate member fee are permitted to use the facility - visitors are not permitted. For the comfort of other members, noise must be kept to a minimum at all times. Smoking (including the use of e-cigarettes) is strictly prohibited within the lodge or within 3 metres of any external doorway. It is highly recommended that persons arrange appropriate insurance cover for the duration of their stay.
